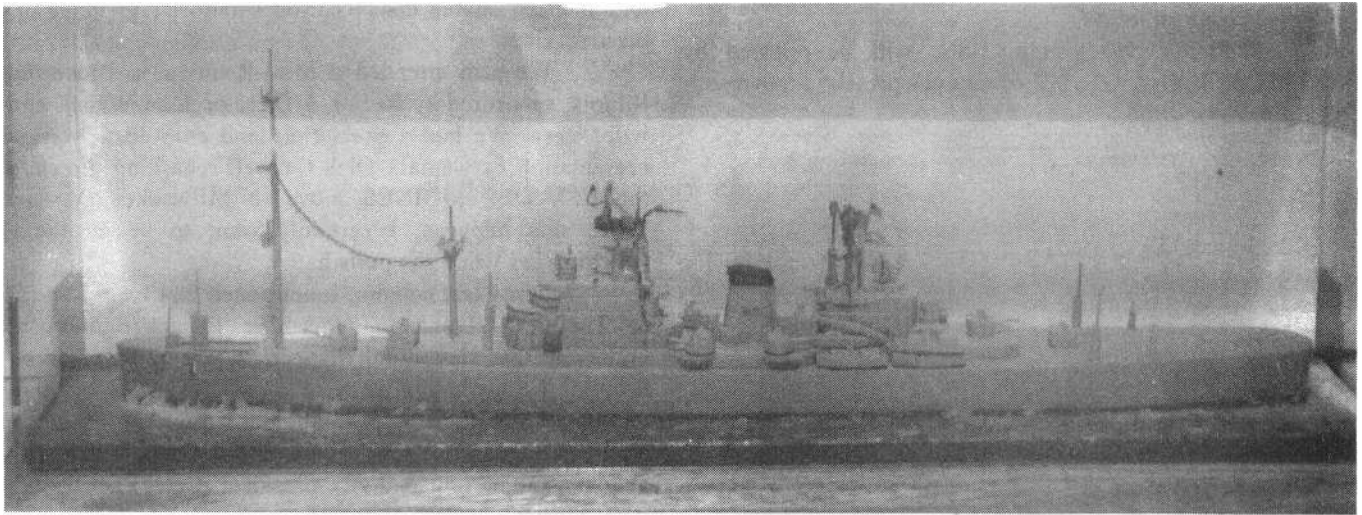


YOUR HELP IS NEEDED

Last year, Len Glaser, former LTjg and ex-Radio Officer of the USS NORTHAMPTON (CLC-1) '55-'57 restored a model of the NORTHAMPTON for display aboard the USS SALEM in Quincy, Massachusetts. This was a model made originally by a now-defunct company, and had been the property of the NORTHAMPTON Reunion Association for many years. It is one-of-a-kind. It was severely damaged at the time, and Len spent several hours and dollars rebuilding it so that it would serve to replicate appropriately this once-proud ship which was scrapped in 1980 in New Jersey.
